Board of Directors Guidelines for Player Placement

As part of the team formation process the NSC Board of Directors in the Fall of 2007 determined that there would be 6 criteria used for player placement on teams.

In order of priority they are:

Age of the Player - players are placed on age appropriate team (age not grade).

The club has no authority to modify this requirement.

Parental request - valid written requests are for a player to "play-up" or be placed on a different team. A parent cannot request a specific team or coach. Request to "play up" will be reviewed by and is at the Boards discretion. A player can only play down using an 8th grade waiver in the Spring season.

Previous Team - a goal of the club is to keep teams together. A player will be placed on the previous team played (consecutive prior season), if the player has been out for a season every effort will be made to place the player on the team previously played if a slot is available.

Experience - we can assign players based on years played in club but a coach can not invite players to play on their team.

Grade - the grade the player is in school. Some players are young for their grade and this criteria can be used as a "tie breaker" to place a younger player on a team with their grade level peers.

In the event that there are too many players for a team the Registrar will assign new players based on criteria 1 through 6 and then by date and time of registration.
