## CAMP PHILOSOPHY

Camp is designed to develop sound fundamental skills that will enable players to have success in their soccer careers. A concentration on teaching the correct fundamental techniques of dribbling, passing, shooting, heading and controlling the ball as well as advanced techniques in accordance with skill level. Since each camper will vary in skill level, it is very important to us that the individual progresses through our camps at the proper levels. At each camp we will group players to provide challenges for every level of play. It is also important to the camp staff that we get to know our campers & have as much fun as possible while working hard & assisting them to reach their goals.
